**FINAL NON-TIME CRITICAL REMOVAL ACTION CLOSURE REPORT FOR
OPERABLE UNIT 2, SITE 5, FORMER FIRE FIGHTERS TRAINING SCHOOL
AT DEFENSE FUEL SUPPORT POINT (DFSP), SAN PEDRO**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed its review of the above-referenced document. This report documented the soil removal activities and the confirmatory soil sampling and analytical results for the former fire fighters training school.

The confirmatory soil analytical results provided showed that the detected concentrations for metals, volatile organic compounds, semi-volatile organic compounds, pesticides, and PCBs were below background and/or residential health-based standards. Based on the information presented, DTSC concurs with the no further action recommendation for Site 5.
